This multi-purpose emergency services facility was designed by MRB Group to fulfill the Village's mission to provide Scottsville residents with a state-of-the-art resource for emergency personnel, which include a volunteer fire department and emergency rescue squad providing advanced life support (ALS/EMS) services.

MRB Group not only provided design and construction administration services, but also provided essential guidance in the pre-planning efforts.

MRB Group design team members met extensively with Fire Department and Rescue Squad members as well as with Village officials. In addition, they attended public hearings in order to form a thorough understanding of the needs of the community.

The result was a functional, efficient, visually appealing, and sustainable operations center providing the community access to the emergency services vital to every resident.

The new fire hall contains seven drive-thru bays, which include full access from the front of the building and partial access in the back. Also included in the design were a diesel exhaust removal system, command / administrative offices and a training / fitness area.
